If the parent/guardian does not present the Certificate of Eligibility and/or the child does not begin within the first five days of the school year, the deposit will not be refunded.

Attendance Policy: The Early Learning Coalition of Duval County requires 80% attendance for VPK students. Should your child not attend 80%, your child will become ineligible and will have to pay tuition of \$380.00 per month as well as an additional \$100.00 registration fee or withdraw their child from the Neptune Baptist WEE School.
