Fees: There are no costs to families for VPK hours, however, Neptune Baptist WEE School charges a \$100.00 supply fee payable at registration.

Attendance Policy: The Early Learning Coalition of Duval County requires 80% attendance for VPK students. Should your child not attend 80%, your child will become ineligible and will have to pay tuition of \$380.00 per month as well as an additional \$100.00 registration fee or withdraw their child from the Neptune Baptist WEE School.

School Hours: 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. Tuesday through Friday.
